We take our kitchen tap for granted, but not everyone has one. Would you like to join us in our tap twinning initiative in Tanzania? Twin your tap with someone who struggles to find sufficient water every day.

CED is building rainwater tanks for some of the poorest people in Tanzania. The water security provided makes a huge difference to the quality of life of the recipients. We are inviting supporters to fund small and large tanks. For each tank supported we will send a fridge magnet with the name of the person whose life you have enhanced, complete with the coordinates so you can find their village on Google. Sometimes it is possible to pick out your actual tank! We hope you will be able to share the picture with friends and have a conversation that may lead to further donations to allow the programme to continue indefinitely. We're small; we talk to people!
